APPLICATION OF CIMAREX ENERGY CO. FOR COMPULSORY POOLING AND CANCELATION OF THE DIVISION'S APPROVAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DRILL ISSUED TO COG OPERATING LLC, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Cimarex Energy Co. applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Glorieta-Yeso formation underlying the SW¼SW¾ of Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M, and canceling the Division's approval of an application for permit to drill ("APD") issued to COG Operating LLC for a well located thereon, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the SW¼SW¼ of Section 2, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Castor 2 State Well No. 1, at an orthodox location, to a depth sufficient to test the Glorieta-Yeso formation, and seeks to dedicate SW¼SW¼ of Section 2 to the well to form a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Loco Hills Glorieta-Yeso Pool.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the SW1/4SW1/4 of Section 2 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests.

Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the SW¼SW¼ of Section 2, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

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- 5. COG Operating LLC has obtained an APD for the Yale State Well No. 1, a Glorieta-Yeso test located in the SW¼SW¼ of Section 2 (API No. 30-015-37459).
- 6. If this pooling application is granted, the APD for the Yale State Well No. 1 must be canceled so that applicant may apply for and receive an APD for its proposed well.
- 7. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the SW¼SW¼ of Section 2, and the canceling of COG Operating LLC's APD, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the SW¼SW¼ of Section 2 from the surface to the base of the Glorieta-Yeso formation;
- B. Designating Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure;
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well; and
- F. Canceling the APD for the Yale State Well No. 1.
