Application of Cimarex Energy Co. for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Cimarex Energy Co. seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests (i) from the surface to the top of the Bone Spring formation underlying the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 35 to form a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit, and (ii) the Bone Spring formation underlying the N/2 N/2 of Section 35 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area). The units are to be dedicated to the Mallon 35 Fed.
