Dear Mr. Crow:

We have reviewed your proposed request for the expansion of the West Covington Strawn Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico. The Commissioner of Public Lands hereb grants Gillespie-Crow, Inc. preliminary approval to expand the boundaries of the West Lovington Strawn Unit.

Expansion of the unit will increase the unit area to 1,618.95 acres. It is our understanding that the following lands containing an additional 160.00 acres will be added to the existing unit area:

Township 15S, Range 35E

Section 34: W/2SE/4
Section 28: S/2SE/4

Preliminary approval shall not be construed to mean final approval of this expansion in any way and will not extend any short term lesses, until final approval and an effective date has been given.

When submitting your agreement for final approval, please submit the following:

- I. Application for final approval by the Commissioner setting forth the tracts that have been committed and the tracts that have not been committed.
- All ratifications from the Lessees of Record and Working Interest Owners. All signatures should be acknowledged by a notary and one set must contain original signatures.
- 3. Evidence that Section 4 "Expansion" of the unit agreement has been complied with
- 4. An amended plan of operation pursuant to Section 11 of the agreement.
- 5. Copies of revised Exhibits "A", "B" and "C".
- 6. Approval by the Bureau of Land Management.
- 7. A copy of the Unit Operating Agreement.
- 8. Our approval will be contingent upon all the applicable New Mexico Oil Conservation requirements being met.
- 9. A re-designation of the well names and numbers.
- 10. The filing fee for a unit agreement expansion is thirty (\$30.00) dollars for every section or partial section thereof. Please submit a filing fee in the amount of \$60.00.
