#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

#### APPLICANT

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the N/2S/2 of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Bradley 30 Fed. Com. Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location 1850 feet from the south line and 330 feet from the west line of Section 29, and

a terminus 1980 feet from the south line and 330 feet from the west line of Section 30. The producing interval of the wellbore will be located wholly within the N½S½ of Section 30. Applicant further seeks approval of the unorthodox location for the well in the Santo Nino-Bone Spring Pool. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
