IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR A NON-STANDARD SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT, UNORTHODOX WELL LOCATION, AND COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY ("Mewbourne") through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order (1) creating a non-standard spacing unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, which will be the horizontal well project area for the Ruger "6" Federal Com No. 5H Well (API No. 30-015-37199) to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 150 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 6 and then in a southerly direction in the third sand interval of the Bone Spring formation, to a bottom hole terminus at a location 330 feet from the South line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 6, (2) approving an unorthodox well location in the Bone Spring formation, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, Winchester Bone Spring Pool, in this non-standard spacing and proration unit - horizontal well project area, and in support of its application states:

1. Mewbourne is a working interest owner in the E/2 W/2 of Section 6, of Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, and has the right to drill thereon. Mewbourne has an interest in each of the 40-acre spacing units in this project area and therefore has standing to bring this pooling application.

2. Mewbourne proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit to its Ruger "6" Federal Com No. 5H Well which it proposes to drill as a horizontal oil well from a surface location 150 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 6 and then in a southerly direction in the third sand interval of the Bone Spring formation, to a bottom hole terminus at a location 330 feet from the South line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 6.

3. This well will penetrate the Bone Spring formation at an unorthodox location 150 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the West line of Section 6. However, the producing interval in the wellbore is within the setback requirements for this project area and therefore within the well's "producing area."

4. Mewbourne has sought and been unable to obtain a voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from certain interest owners in the subject spacing units who are identified on Exhibit A to this application.

5. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

6. In order to permit the Mewbourne to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Mewbourne Oil Company should be designated the operator of this non-standard spacing unit and the well to be drilled thereon.

WHEREFORE, Mewbourne Oil Company requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 3, 2011 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. creating a non-standard spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation, Winchester Bone Spring Pool, comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM;
- B. Approving an unorthodox location in the Bone spring formation 150 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the West line of Section 6.
- C. pooling all mineral interests in the subject spacing and proration units;
- D. designating Mewbourne Oil Company operator of this unit and the well to be drilled thereon;
- E. authorizing Mewbourne Oil Company to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well;
- F. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after

completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and

- G. imposing a penalty for the risk assumed by Mewbourne Oil Company in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.

CASE 14603: **Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for a non-standard spacing and proration unit unorthodox well location, and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.** Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order creating a non-standard spacing unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 6, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM; and pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, Winchester Bone Spring Pool, in this non-standard spacing and proration unit which spacing unit will be the project area for its proposed Ruger "6" Federal Com No. 5H Well (API No. 30-015-37199) to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 150 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 6 and then in a southerly direction in the third sand interval of the Bone Spring formation, to a bottom hole terminus at a location 330 feet from the South line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 6. This well will penetrate the Bone Spring formation at an unorthodox location 150 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the West line of Section 6, however, the producing interval in the wellbore is within the well's "producing area." Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Mewbourne Oil Company as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.
