That was the -- the other case was Energen 8 Resources Corporation Application for allowable reduction, 9 West Lovington Strawn Unit, Lea County, New Mexico. 10 The two cases have been consolidated, and the Applications have 11 been referred back to the Division's Hearing Examiners for 12 consideration. 13

There have been some developments in that particular matter that we think require the attention of the Division's Hearing Examiners before they come back to the Commission, so that's where that particular matter stands. And there's a copy of the letter to the parties in your notebooks, Commissioners.
