WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:22 a.m.: EXAMINER CATANACH: At this time I'll call Case 3 13,223, the Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for 4 approval of a unit agreement, Lea County, New Mexico. 5 Call for appearances. 6 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is 7 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe office of Holland and 8 Hart, L.L.P. We represent Yates Petroleum Corporation in 9 this matter, and I will present the case on affidavit. 10 11 EXAMINER CATANACH: Any additional appearances? Mr. Carr, you may proceed. 12 MR. CARR: Mr. Catanach, like the preceding case 13 this Application involves the approval of a voluntary 14 15 exploratory unit. The name of the unit is the Merle, M-e-r-l-e, State Exploratory Unit. It is comprised of 16 7351.04 acres of State of New Mexico lands, and it is 17 18 located approximately 4 miles southwest of Crossroads, New 19 Mexico. 100 percent of the working interest in these lands is owned by Yates Petroleum Corporation and its affiliated 20 companies, and Yates proposes to test all formations from 21 22 the surface through the Austin formation. 23 Yates seeks approval of this proposed unit 24 pursuant to an affidavit submitted -- or prepared by John

Amiet, petroleum geologist for Yates Petroleum Corporation.

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Attached to Mr. Amiet's affidavit is a fully executed copy of the unit agreement on the State Land Office form.

Tab B is the plat to the unit agreement, which identifies the unit boundary. The initial test well will be located at a standard gas well location 1650 feet from the east line and 1250 feet from south line of Section 13.

Tab C is a copy of Schedule B to the unit agreement, which confirms 100 percent of the working interest is owned by Yates and affiliated companies.

Tab D is the letter from the Commissioner of Public Lands giving preliminary approval to the formation of this unit.

And Tab E is a net sand isopach of the Austin limestone, illustrating that the limestone thins in a way which corresponds to Yates' projection of the sand trend in this area. Morrow sands are the main producing objective in this unit.

Tab F to the affidavit is a structural crosssection of the Morrow sands in the proposed unit area. Mr.
Amiet by affidavit testifies that approval of this unit and
development of the area under the plan is in the best
interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the
protection of correlative rights.

We request that Yates Exhibit 1 be admitted into evidence.

EXAMINER CATANACH: Yates Exhibit Number 1 1 2 will be admitted. Mr. Catanach, there is a lease in the 3 MR.
