


JILLSON FEDERAL SWD #1

Dear Sir:

The land described below (Rio Arriba County) is owned by the Federal Government as Public Domain and managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM).

T. 24 N., R. 3 W. Section 8

Both surface and subsurface rights are presently owned by the Federal Government. The subsurface rights to oil and gas are held by Meridian Oil Corporation. The BLM Albuquerque District Office, Rio Puerco Resource Area, has been working with Meridian to permit and drill the Jillson Saltwater Disposal Well in this quarter section of Federal lease #SF-080472. The permitting of this well will follow standard permitting procedures for a disposal well.

Because the area was previously administered out of the BLM Farmington District Office, we continue to coordinate with them. Again, we emphasis that at this time the above described land is owned by the Federal Government and managed by the BLM Rio Puerco Resource Area.
