ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on September 1, 1994, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Jim Morrow.

NOW, on this 6th day of September, 1994, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Collins and Ware, Inc., seeks authority to re-enter the previously plugged and abandoned C & K Petroleum, Inc. West Airport Federal Com (Unit) Well No. 1-Y located 2250 feet from the North line and 998 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 29, Township 22 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, and to utilize said well to dispose of produced salt water into the Bell Canyon member of the Undesignated Happy Valley-Delaware Pool through the open-hole interval from approximately 2304 feet to 2396 feet.
- (3) By letter dated August 24, 1994, the applicant requested this case be dismissed.
- (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.

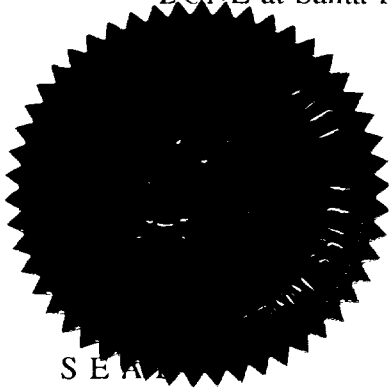
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
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
