Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Gentlemen:

Astec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{3}{4}$ Township 30 North, Range 12 West, S.M.R.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Astec-J. Hudson No. 2 well, located 990 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the East line of Section 34, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, was completed August 25, 1946 as a gas well, and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's line on October 7, 1946.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 160 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That so far as is known to Applicant, the following company constitutes the only company, other than Applicant, owning an interest in any of the acreage included in or offsetting the proposed unit, and such company is being notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit by the mailing of a copy of this application to it:
