

WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:13 a.m.: EXAMINER MORROW: At this time we will call Case 3 Number 11,121 and call for appearances. 4 MR. STOGNER: Mr. Examiner, Case Number 11,121 is 5 in the matter of the Oil Conservation Division upon our own 6 motion for an order creating, contracting and extending 7 certain pools in Eddy County, New Mexico, which falls under 8 our District 2 Office in Artesia. 9 I'm Michael E. Stogner, petroleum engineer, here 10 in Santa Fe appearing on behalf of the OCD, and I will be 11 12 putting on testimony. EXAMINER MORROW: All right. 13 MICHAEL E. STOGNER, 14 the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon 15 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: 16 EXAMINER MORROW: Go ahead, Mr. Stogner, present 17 your information. 18 MR. STOGNER: Mr. Morrow, I have in front of me 19 Exhibit Number 1, which is a set of maps for our 20 nomenclature, to be included in our regular nomenclature 21 proceedings. 22 The way this is done is that operators of oil and 23 gas wells will approach the District Office for creation, 24 extension or contraction of certain pools. At that time 25

they get with the geologists and oversee the records.

The geologist then prepares an exhibit to be advertised and sent up to Santa Fe for our perusal, and we then at this time present it as testimony to be included in the regular nomenclature. That gives a regular, standard procedure in which this is done, and it's worked well over the years.

Exhibit Number 1, I'd like for you to refer to it, which I have in front of me, and also today's docket, and there are no changes from what appears on the docket with what is included within the maps to be included in our nomenclature.

If you'll go down to paragraphs (d) and (e), (d) being the contraction of the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool and (e) being the extension of the South Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool, that was mentioned in the previous case that Santa Fe Energy Operating Partners, L.P., put on in Case 11,112.

I would ask that that particular case and the proceedings in it be -- administrative notice be taken of all that information presented by them.

EXAMINER MORROW: Okay, sir.

MR. STOGNER: And that's all I have at this time, and I would seek that Exhibit Number 1 be admitted into evidence.
