Case No. 11129 was originally heard on November 8, 1994. At that time the proposed well was at an unorthodox location 2130 feet from the South line and 510 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 17 South, Range 37 East. AnSon presented geological and land testimony at the hearing. The case was continued so that AnSon could give notice to the offset owners.

The application for Case No. 11129 was amended, and the amended proposed well is at an unorthodox location 2130 feet from the South line and 410 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 17 South, Range 37 East. The continued case is scheduled to be heard on January 19, 1995. Notice of the amended location was provided to all offset owners. The geological testimony for the amended location will be identical to the testimony that was presented on November 8, 1994, with the exception that the isopach map, which is enclosed with this letter, will show the amended location. For this reason, AnSon Gas Corporation

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respectfully requests that the geological testimony from the November 8, 1994, hearing be incorporated into the January 19, 1995 testimony.


