Amoco Production Company hereby makes application for exception to NMOCD general rule 303(A) to downhole commingle production from the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool in the Ruth #1 well. The well is proposed to be drilled at a legal location 940' FNL and 790' FEL of Section 8, T31N-R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico. In support of this application, Amoco states the following:

- 1. Amoco is the operator of the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool underlying the NE/4 Section 8, T31N-R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico which will be dedicated to the Ruth #1 well.
- 2. Amoco is the operator of the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool underlying the N/2 Section 8, T31N-R10W, San Juan County, New Mexico which will be dedicated to the Ruth #1 well.
- 3. The ownership of the formations proposed for commingling is not common (WI, RI, ORI).
- 4.Development of the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool with separate wells for each pool would be uneconomic and downhole commingling is necessary to economically produce the two formations.
- 5. Approval of this application will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
