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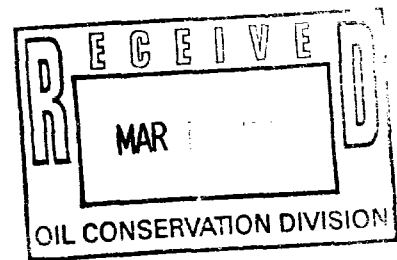

This Order provides that Maralo shall commence drilling on this pooled unit on or before March 15, 1995, unless this time is extended for good cause shown.


Maralo, Inc. intends to drill this well as soon as data from offsetting drilling is available. This data is necessary to minimize the risk associated with the development of the subject acreage.
