

1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 2 8:28 a.m.: EXAMINER STOGNER: Call Case Number 11,176. 3 MR. CARROLL: Application of Amoco Production 4 5 Company to amend Division Order Number R-10,174 to include provisions for an unorthodox surface gas well location, 6 7 simultaneous dedication, and an exception to Rule 2(b) of 8 the Special Rules governing the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. 9 EXAMINER STOGNER: At this time I'll call for 10 11 appearances. 12 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is 13 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr, 14 Berge and Sheridan. 15 I represent Amoco Production Company in this 16 matter, and I have a statement to make on behalf of Amoco. 17 EXAMINER STOGNER: Are there any other 18 appearances? 19 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom Kellahin 20 appearing on behalf of Conoco, Inc. 21 EXAMINER STOGNER: Do you have any statements, Mr. Kellahin? 22 23 MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir, very briefly. 24 EXAMINER STOGNER: Let's see, since Amoco was the 25 Applicant, Mr. Kellahin, I'll let you go first, if you're

prepared.

2 MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir.

Your case file will indicate that Conoco filed a prehearing statement and an objection to approval of this particular Application by Amoco.

I'm here to advise you that we have already submitted a letter to the Division withdrawing that objection.

Amoco and Conoco have, outside the hearing process, resolved their differences, and therefore we have withdrawn our objection to approval of the Application.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Thank you, Mr. Kellahin.

Mr. Carr?

MR. CARR: Mr. Stogner, as you will recall, this matter came before you in August of 1994, on the Application of Amoco for approval of a high-angle/horizontal directional drilling pilot project within the east half of Section 6, Township 30 North, Range 8 West.

The Application was approved by Order dated August 25, 1994, the Order bearing Number R-10,174, and that was entered in Case 10,054.

Following the approval of the Application, Amoco discovered that the surface location of the horizontal well had to be moved. And because of that, the case was put on the docket again bearing a new case number and advertised

as it is today, in a fashion that provided in the absence 1 of objection the Application would be taken under 2 advisement. 3 4 Following the re-notification of affected 5 interest owners, Conoco contacted the Division, raised an 6 objection, and as Mr. Kellahin has indicated, that has now 7 been resolved. 8 And so Amoco would request that based on the 9 prior record and the data submitted at the time the 10 Application that led to this case was actually filed, that 11 based on that information, you take the case under 12 advisement. 13 EXAMINER STOGNER: Does anybody else have anything further in Case Number 11,176 at this time? 14 The matter will be taken under advisement. 15 16 Thank you, gentlemen.
