Reference is made to the subject application to have been set for hearing on December 17, 1994. An initial review of this request indicates the well directly offsets the Los Medanos-Wolfcamp Gas Pool to the north in Section 25, Township 22 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Your application indicated the Wolfcamp to be an oil producing interval.

Additional information will be required before this matter will be set for hearing. What 320-acre unit will be dedicated to the Wolfcamp interval and the unorthodox gas well location would require approval before the well could produce from the Wolfcamp zone. Your application should include such a provision.
