APPLICATION

BONNEVILLE FUELS CORPORATION through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an unorthodox well location in the Strawn formation, and in support of this application states:

- 1. Applicant is the operator of the E/2 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico and proposes to drill a well in the Strawn formation, South Humble City-Strawn Pool, at an unorthodox location 2030 feet from the South line and 2300 feet from the West line of said Section 14.
- 2. Applicant seeks an exception to Rule 4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Humble City-Strawn Pool to permit the drilling of this well at the above-described location.
- 3. The above-described 80-acre standard proration unit should be dedicated to the well.
- 4. Approval of this application will afford applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil and gas from the Strawn formation and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of

correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 6, 1995, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Division enter its Order granting this application and providing such other relief as is proper.
