NOW, on this 30th day of May, 1995, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

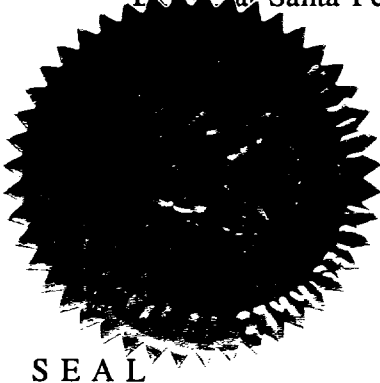
FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Amoco Production Company, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Undesignated West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool underlying the NE/4 of Section 14, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit. Said unit is to be dedicated to the Roberts Well No. 1 to be drilled and completed at a standard gas well location thereon.
- (3) This applicant requested at the time of the hearing to dismiss this matter.
- (4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
