POWER OF ATTORNEY

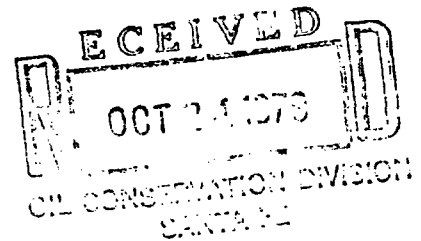
