Reference is made to your application dated September 30, 1994, on behalf of the operator Amerada Hess Corporation, for a non-standard gas well location for the North Bell Lake Federai Well No. 2 to be drilled 1100 feet from the South line and 1500 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 5, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, to test the Ellenburger formation, Lea County, New Mexico. 


North Bell Lake Federal #2 Flow Test

Consider Material Balance in Gas Reservoirs (Applied Petroleum Reservoir Engineering, Craft and Hawkins, pp. 43.):

 $Gp Bg = G (Bg - Bgi) \qquad Gp = G(1 - (Bgi / Bg)) \qquad G = Gp/(1 - (Bgi / Bg))$

If Gp = Average Recovery of Ellenburger Wells = 12,105 MMSCF; then,

G = Gas-in-Place = 12,105 MMSCF / (1 - (.003228 / .013878)) = 15,774 MMSCF

Consider a volumetric solution for areal extent (Applied Petroleum Reservoir Engineering, Craft and Hawkins, pp. 26.):

G = 43,560 (A) (h) (porosity) (1 - Sw) / Bg

A = Area = (15,774,000,000 SCF) (.003228) / (43,560) (65) (.035) (1 - 0.21) = 650 acres

Comments:

Based on reasonable assumptions for the Ellenburger formation, it is theoretically possible that the North Bell Lake Federal #2 could drain an area of at least 640 acres.
