APPLICATION

AnSon Gas Corporation, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to Oil Conservation Division Rule 111 to directionally drill its AnSon Byers 12L No. 1 Well to the Strawn formation, South Humble City-Strawn Pool, and in support of this application states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the N/2 SW/4 of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
2. Applicant proposes to re-enter the plugged Nearburg Byers 12L No. 1 Well at a surface location 1980 feet from the South line and 810 feet from the West line of said Section 12, and directionally drill to a proposed unorthodox bottomhole location within 50 feet of a point 1650 feet from the South line and 900 feet from the West line of said Section 12, with the intent of testing the Strawn formation.
3. Applicant proposes to dedicate to the AnSon Byers 12L No. 1 Well a standard spacing or proration unit comprised of the N/2 SW/4 of said Section 12.


4. Directionally drilling this well will enable AnSon Gas Corporation to efficiently produce the reserves which underlie the above-described proration unit.

5. Approval of this application will enable the Applicant to produce hydrocarbons that otherwise would not be produced and will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 15, 1995, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Division enter its Order granting this application and providing such other relief as is proper.
