Dear Mr. Weant:

IMC Global Operations, Inc., has received your notification that Stevens & Tull, Inc., intends to drill the above referenced well with no salt string protection. IMC objects to this well being drilled without the salt string because of its proximity to IMC's potash reserves in section 8.

This location is approximately 3200' from our ore reserves in Section 8. An existing well - State #2, 660 FNL & 660 FWL, Sec. 16 - lies between our reserves and the proposed Conoco State #1. This existing well, however, was drilled with salt string protection. Should Conoco State #1 be drilled without salt string protection, it would pose an additional hazard to our mining operations.

IMC Global, Inc., protests drilling this well without a potash protection string.
