WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 2:50 p.m.: 3 4 5 6 EXAMINER STOGNER: Hearing will come to order. 7 Call next Case, Number 11,340, which is in the matter of 8 9 the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division upon its own motion for an order creating and extending certain 10 pools in Chaves and Lea Counties, New Mexico. 11 And, inasmuch as Case 11,341 is in the matter of 12 the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division upon 13 its own motion for an order creating and extending certain 14 pools in Chaves and Eddy Counties, New Mexico, I'm going to 15 consolidate these two cases and at this time call for 16 17 appearances. MR. CARROLL: Yes, Mr. Examiner, my name is Rand 18 Carroll, appearing on behalf of the New Mexico Oil 19 Conservation Division. 20 I have one witness to be sworn. 21 EXAMINER STOGNER: And if there's no other 2.2 23 appearances, will the witness please stand? 24 (Thereupon, the witness was sworn.) 25 EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Carroll?

ROY JOHNSON,

the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon his oath, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. CARROLL:

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- Q. Mr. Johnson, would you please state your name, your employer and your position with your employer for the record, please?
- A. My name is Roy Johnson. I'm Senior Petroleum Geologist with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division here in Santa Fe.
- Q. And have you testified before the Division before and had your qualifications accepted?
- 14 A. Yes.
- Q. And today are you prepared to make
 recommendations concerning the nomenclature in certain
 pools in Eddy and Chaves Counties -- no, Chaves and Lea
 Counties, New Mexico, and in Chaves and Eddy Counties, New
 Mexico?
- 20 A. I am.
- Q. And how are your recommendations set forth?
- A. In forms of exhibits, Exhibit Number 1 in both cases.
- Q. All right. And have you had the opportunity to review the Exhibits Numbered 1 in each case and compare it

with the docket that's been prepared for today's hearing to 1 determine if there's any discrepancy between the two? 2 Yes, I have, and there are no discrepancies. Α. 3 However, we do ask that in Case 11,341, that 4 Paragraph (b), as in "boy", be dismissed. 5 MR. CARROLL: So, Mr. Examiner, I would ask that 6 Paragraph (b) in Case Number 11,341 be dismissed. 7 EXAMINER STOGNER: Let the record show that the 8 9 creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, that was to be known as the Southwest Forty Niner Ridge-Delaware 10 Pool, is hereby dismissed. 11 MR. CARROLL: Mr. Examiner, I have nothing 12 further of this witness, and I offer Exhibits Number 1 and 13 1 into the record in Cases 11,340 and 11,341. 14 EXAMINER STOGNER: Both Exhibits 1 will be 15 admitted into evidence at this time. I have no questions 16 of Mr. Johnson. He may be excused. 17 Is there anything else further in either Case 18 11,340 or 11,341? 19 20 MR. CARROLL: No. 21 EXAMINER STOGNER: There being none, these cases will be taken under advisement, and hearing adjourned. 22 (Thereupon, these proceedings were concluded at 23 2:52 p.m.) 24 * * * 25
