the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon
his oath, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. CARROLL:

Q. Mr. Johnson, would you please state your name,
your employer and your position with your employer for the
record, please?

A. My name is Roy Johnson. I'm Senior Petroleum
Geologist with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division
here in Santa Fe.

Q. And have you testified before the Division before
and had your qualifications accepted?

A. Yes.

Q. And today are you prepared to make
recommendations concerning the nomenclature in certain
pools in Eddy and Chaves Counties -- no, Chaves and Lea
Counties, New Mexico, and in Chaves and Eddy Counties, New
Mexico?

A. I am.

Q. And how are your recommendations set forth?

A. In forms of exhibits, Exhibit Number 1 in both
cases.

Q. All right. And have you had the opportunity to
review the Exhibits Numbered 1 in each case and compare it

1 with the docket that's been prepared for today's hearing to
2 determine if there's any discrepancy between the two?

3 A. Yes, I have, and there are no discrepancies.

4 However, we do ask that in Case 11,341, that
5 Paragraph (b), as in "boy", be dismissed.

6 MR. CARROLL: So, Mr. Examiner, I would ask that
7 Paragraph (b) in Case Number 11,341 be dismissed.

8 EXAMINER STOGNER: Let the record show that the
9 creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, that was
10 to be known as the Southwest Forty Niner Ridge-Delaware
11 Pool, is hereby dismissed.

12 MR. CARROLL: Mr. Examiner, I have nothing
13 further of this witness, and I offer Exhibits Number 1 and
14 1 into the record in Cases 11,340 and 11,341.

15 EXAMINER STOGNER: Both Exhibits 1 will be
16 admitted into evidence at this time. I have no questions
17 of Mr. Johnson. He may be excused.

18 Is there anything else further in either Case
19 11,340 or 11,341?

20 MR. CARROLL: No.

21 EXAMINER STOGNER: There being none, these cases
22 will be taken under advisement, and hearing adjourned.


