

CASE 11343:

Application of Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing in the N/2 of Section 27, in all formations developed on 160-acre spacing in the NW/4 of Section 27 and in all formations developed on 80-acre spacing in the E/2 NW/4 of Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 33 East. Said unit is to be dedicated to the Spessartine "27" State Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard location 1980 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 27 to a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation, Undesignated Legg Atoka-Morrow Gas Pool. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 24 miles west, northwest of Eunice, New Mexico.
