#### **APPLICANT**

Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Oil Conservation Division Rule 104 to permit the drilling of the well at the above-described unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Devonian Formation. Approval of this application will result in the production of hydrocarbons which otherwise would not be produced, will protect correlative rights, and will be in the best interest of conservation.
