Brenner, Certified Court Reporter No. 7 for the State of New Mexico.

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1	WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2	9:00 a.m.:
3	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Good morning, this is the Oil
4	Conservation Commission. My name is Bill LeMay, Chairman
5	of the Commission. To my left is Commissioner Bill Weiss,
6	to my right Commissioner Jami Bailey representing the
7	Commissioner of Public Lands. Welcome to our meeting
8	today.
9	We shall start by calling Case Number 11,352,
10	which is the matter called by the Oil Conservation Division
11	to amend Rule 116 of the General Rules and regulations.
12	My understanding is that this case will be
13	continued. Is there a date which you want this case
14	continued to?
15	MS. ANDREWS: I'm not sure I'm Ruth Andrews
16	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Yes, Ruth?
17	MS. ANDREWS: New Mexico Oil and Gas. I'm not
18	sure what date has been set. Roger, have you been told
19	where we're headed?
20	MR. ANDERSON: There wasn't anything discussed at
21	the Committee as to how long it was going to take to
22	continue to finish the work.
23	MS. ANDREWS: We're at a fairly complicated part
24	of the negotiating right now, and it might take as much as
25	two or more months to get through this part of it.

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1 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: And then you still have more to look at? 2 MS. ANDREWS: 3 Yes. 4 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Well, if we continued the case for four months, and then if you needed more time, we can 5 always give you -- Is that acceptable? 6 7 MS. ANDREWS: I think that's perfect. CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Let's continue this case to the 8 9 August hearing of the Commission. We don't have a date as of yet, but we need to get some Commission dates through 10 the last half of the year also. But it will be the 11 12 Commission date in August. 13 Without objection, Case Number 11,352, dealing with amending Rule 116, will be continued to the August 14 15 Commission hearing. 16 * * 17 Before we get into the one case we will be considering today, we do have some business to take care 18 19 of. 20 Before you, fellow Commissioners, I think you 21 have the proration order, which we heard on the February 22 hearing, and is it your intent to take final action and 23 sign this order today? COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, it is. 24 25 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Thank you, Commissioner Bailey.

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Commissioner Weiss? 1 COMMISSIONER WEISS: Yes. 2 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Thank you. 3 Let the record show that final action has been 4 taken on Case Number 11,468, which is the proration order. 5 * * * 6 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: I will entertain a motion by my 7 fellow Commissioners to accept the minutes of the March 8 9 12th hearing. 10 COMMISSIONER WEISS: I move that we accept the minutes of the March 12th hearing. 11 12 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Thank you. COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I second. 13 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Thank you. We all agree that 14 the minutes of the March 12th hearing will be accepted. 15 Let the record so show. 16 * * * 17 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: With -- That's the final action; 18 I think we're going to take the de novo? 19 MS. DAVIDSON: The Nunc pro tunc order. 20 21 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: The nunc pro tunc order. Have you looked at the nunc pro tunc order, 22 fellow Commissioners? Well, maybe we should do that after 23 the break. It's not a very long one. We'll postpone that 24 25 order.

3	CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Oh, okay. Do you want to look
