MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE

Titan Resources, L.P. (Titan) hereby moves for a continuance of the hearing in the above case and, in support thereof, states:

1. At the request of Nearburg Exploration Company (Nearburg), the above case is scheduled for hearing on February 15, 1996.

2. The case concerns the Dagger Draw SWD Well No. 1, located in Unit E of Section 22, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. At the time of the Division hearing in this case, Anadarko Petroleum Corporation (Anadarko) operated the subject well, and entered an appearance objecting to Nearburg's application.

3. Anadarko recently sold its interest in the subject well to Titan. Titan has had insufficient time to review this matter and prepare for hearing, and thus requests a continuance until the March 12, 1996 Commission hearing.




4. Titan has requested the concurrence of Nearburg in this case. Nearburg does not object to the continuance.


