Tamarack Petroleum Company, Inc. received administrative approval to commingle their Saunders Permo Upper Penn Pool production the <u>24th day of July, 1995</u>, **COMMINGLING ORDER CTB-411**, by separately metering the production from each lease prior to commingling. TPC, as operator, cannot justify installing and operating separate metering equipment on these wells. Surface commingling these leases into one central battery without well metering will enable the wells to produce more economically and reduce operating costs, such that it will extend the life of these leases and increase ultimate recovery from these properties.
