Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc., hereby makes application for an order approving an unorthodox oil well location, and in support thereof states:

- 1. Applicant is the operator of Lot 2 (NW¼NE¼ equivalent) of Section 6, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Mesa Verde 6 Fed. Well No. 7 at an unorthodox location 660 feet from the North line and 2540 feet from the East line of Section 6, to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, at approximately 8950 feet subsurface (Mesa Verde-Bone Spring Pool). Applicant will dedicate Lot 2 of Section 6 to the Well, forming a standard 40.08 acre oil spacing and proration unit.
- 3. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste, and will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells.
