This letter is in response to your request for a compatibility evaluation between Bone Springs, Wolfcamp, and Delaware water. This evaluation is made on the basis of the commingled Bone Springs and Wolfcamp record from James Ranch #71 reported on laboratory #1294201-A (1-3-95) and the Delaware waters from James Ranch #19 and #37 reported on laboratory #1293233 (1-5-94).

A careful examination of the above analyses has provided no evidence of any incompatibility between the commingled Bone Springs and Wolf-Wolfcamp waters and Delaware. More specifically, the evidence indicates that these waters can be mixed in any proportion without any scaling potential or precipitation resulting from this mixture.
