3 EXAMINER CATANACH: And at this time we'll call
4 Case 11,436.

5 MR. CARROLL: Application of Armstrong Energy
6 Corporation for approval of a pressure maintenance project
7 and qualification for the Recovered Oil Tax Rate, Lea
8 County, New Mexico.

9 EXAMINER CATANACH: Are there any appearances in
10 this case?

11 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is
12 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr
13 and Berge. We represent Armstrong Energy Corporation in
14 this matter.

15 The case was heard by Examiner Stogner on
16 December the 7th.

17 At the time of hearing, it was discovered that
18 notice had not been provided to the Land Office, the owner
19 of the surface of the land on which the well is to be
20 located.

21 The case was continued to this date to provide
22 the Land Office an opportunity to review the C-108 and
23 attachment materials, and a request was made that they
24 waive objection to the location.

25 We have reviewed the Application with the State

1 Land Office, and a letter from the Commissioner has been
2 sent to Mr. Stogner, waiving any objection to the location
3 and supporting the Application filed by Armstrong in this
4 matter.

5 We therefore would request the case now be taken
6 under advisement.

7 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. There being no
8 additional appearances or testimony or evidence in this
9 case, Case 11,436 will be taken under advisement.
