WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:02 a.m.: EXAMINER STOGNER: At this time I'll call Case 3 4 Number 11,446. MR. CARROLL: Application of Arch Petroleum, 5 Inc., for amendment of Division Order R-10,453 authorizing 6 7 a location change of a certain unorthodox oil well location, Lea County, New Mexico. 8 EXAMINER STOGNER: This case was heard and an 9 Order, R-10,453, was approved which authorized the drilling 10 of seven wells and unorthodox oil well location, Sections 11 21, 22 and 28 of 23 South, 37 East, in the Teague-Blinebry 12 13 Pool, down in southeast New Mexico. One particular well had to be moved for reasons 14 15 stated in the Application in this matter. 16 At this time I will call for any appearances or 17 testimony to be presented. MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is 18 19 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr and Berge. 20 21 We represent Arch Petroleum, Inc., in this 22 matter. As the Examiner has stated, the C.E. Lamunyon 23 Well Number 56, which was approved at an unorthodox 24 location in September by Order Number 10,453, had to be 25

moved because when it was being staked it was discovered to 1 be virtually on top of a Sid Richardson pipeline. 2 to be moved 150 feet to the west, which is actually toward 3 4 a standard location, although it's still unorthodox. And we request that based on this Application and 5 the administrative filing previously submitted for this 6 7 well, that the case be taken under advisement and the change in this location be approved. 8 It is the only well in the seven-well package 9 that cannot be drilled at the location requested at the 10 11 prior hearing. EXAMINER STOGNER: And when you said it had to be 12 13 moved, you said the well, as opposed to the Sid Richardson Pipeline? 14 MR. CARR: It was on top -- Yes, it would have 15 been more convenient for them to move the pipeline, but 16 17 they weren't interested. 18 EXAMINER STOGNER: If there's nothing else further in Case Number 11,446, this matter will be taken 19 under advisement. 20 (Thereupon, these proceedings were concluded at 21 22 9:04 a.m.) I do hereby certify that the foregoing is a complete record of the proceedings in 23 the Examiner negrips of Case No. 24
