This letter is to advise you that Yates Petroleum Corporation has filed the enclosed amended application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order amending the Special Rules and Regulations for the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool to provide for no more than one well per 80-acres, to allow the simultaneous dedication of acreage to both oil and gas wells, a special limiting gas-oil ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas for each barrel of oil produced and a special oil allowable for the pool of 1400 barrels of oil per day.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on March 21, 1996.
