



\*\* While running a BHP SVY on the State "S" #1 from 7/19/96 to 7/29/96 the WLSU wells were put on production while the State "S" was kept shut-in. At the time the WLSU field was put back on production the pressure build-up curve in the State "S" #1 immediately flattened indicating extremely good pressure communication with the rest of the field. (the curve then declined)

\*\* The Average Bottom Hole Pressure of the WLSU pool on 7/19/96 was 3279 psia.
