Mr. Lemay:

Pursuant to the hearing to take place on October 17, 1996 on commingling we would like to ensure that the following items are addressed in the hearing.

Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company has stated on page four item 14 that "The value of the commingled production will not be less than the sum of the values of the individual production." They have not given any assurances to the owners and interest holders what their cost of comminging will be. Specifically, will the cost of commingling the wells cause any owner or interest holder to incur additional costs which puts them in a worse position than they would be without commingling?

If owners perceive that they may be in worse position with commingling than without, what is the owners recourse? Do they have any recourse other than the terms of their lease?

I am submitting this letter because I am not sure that a representative from Mar Oil and Gas will be a able to attend the hearing. I would appreciate someone from your office contacting Mrs. Romero, 473-1937 or I, Tim Burrell at 983-1112 regarding availability of minutes of the hearing.
