And we are here because of a special meeting that we called about 78 hours ago, I think, a little over three days ago, to consider Case Number 11,666 and Case Number 11,677, relating to competitive force pooling applications and request to be operator by KCS Medallion Resources, Inc., formerly InterCoast Oil and Gas Company, and Yates Petroleum Corporation.

The reason for this special meeting is the fact that there is a well currently drilling on the prospect, which Medallion is operating under an existing order issued by the Division.

And because of the nature of force pooling applications, there is an election period by which those parties can either elect to join in the drilling of the well, paying their proportionate share of costs, or be force pooled with a penalty: But that election needs to be made as soon as possible, because of the nature of this

situation where the well is already drilling on the 1 project. Normally in these applications there's enough 2 time involved so that an order like this could be signed at 3 the next meeting, and there would be time for the election 4 to be made, but that is not the case in this order. 5 So we do have the orders here, and I'd like to 6 ask Commissioner Bailey if it's her intent to sign the 7 8 order, if she has any comments? 9 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: It is my intent to sign. 10 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Fine. It is also my intent to sign the order.
