Dear Mr. LeMay:

By order No. R-10790 entered on April 14, 1997, the Oil Conservation Division (OCD) granted to Yates Petroleum Corporation authority to re-enter the previously plugged and abandoned Shell Oil Company G. L. Lusk Well No. 3, to be redesignated the Shell Lusk "ANB" Well No. 1 located at a surface location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F), Section 11, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico and recomplete the well by side tracking from the vertical position and directionally drilling to a proposed bottomhole location 1650 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 11 at a depth of approximately 12,253 feet.

The order provides that "the operator shall commence re-entry operations and the recompletion of said well on or before the fifteenth day of July, 1997..." Because of the tight rig situation, we have been unable to procure a rig to drill this well. In addition, we are awaiting a driveway permit from the State Highway Department District 2. Due to these delays, we respectfully request that the July 15, 1997 commencement date be extended for a period of 45 days to September 1, 1997 in order to assure that this well can be timely drilled.
