APPLICATION

KCS MEDALLION RESOURCES, INC., ("KCS Medallion"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing underlying the E/2, in all formations developed on 160-acre spacing underlying the SE/4, in all formations developed on 80-acre spacing underlying the S/2 SE/4 and in all formations developed on 40-acre spacing underlying the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

- 1. KCS Medallion owns or represents approximately 62.50% of the working interest in the E/2 of said Section 14, and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. KCS Medallion proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing or proration unit to its Aid State No. 14-1 Well which it proposes to drill at an unorthodox well location 660 feet from the South line and 1,330 feet from the East line of said Section 14.

- 3. KCS Medallion proposes to drill to a depth of 10,650 feet to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation.
- 4. KCS Medallion has sought and been unable to obtain either voluntary agreement for pooling or farmout from certain interest owners in the E/2 of said Section 14.
 - 5. Said pooling of interests will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
- 6. In order to permit KCS Medallion to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Applicant should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled at the proposed unorthodox well location.

WHEREFORE, KCS Medallion Resources, Inc., respectfully requests that this application be set for hearing before an examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 20, 1997 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including provisions for Applicant to recover its costs of supervision of the well, including overhead charges, imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well and approving an unorthodox location for the well 660 feet from the South line and 1,330 feet from the East line of said Section 14.
