**APPLICATION OF MANZANO OIL CORPORATION FOR AN UNORTHODOX
OIL WELL LOCATION, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.**

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on April 3, 1997, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 9th day of April, 1997, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Manzano Oil Corporation, seeks approval to drill its "SV" Kim Harris Well No. 3 at an unorthodox oil well location to test the Northeast Lovington-Pennsylvanian Pool 242 feet from the North line and 2148 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 12, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The N/2 NE/4 of said Section 12 is to be dedicated to the well to form a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

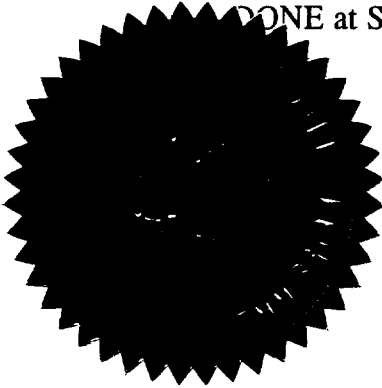
(3) Prior to the hearing the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


Case No. 11761 is hereby dismissed.
