Merrion Oil & Gas plans to drill the Powell #1 in the SE/4 of the NE/4 of Section 22, T 32N, R 13W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The spacing unit is made up of a number of fee and one federal lease. Because of difficulty locating and/or negotiating with one mineral owner, Merrion has been unable to obtain leases on all the acreage in the spacing unit. Therefore, Merrion requests your approval for compulsory pooling of these interests for the drilling of this well based upon terms and conditions which include:

- a.) Merrion Oil & Gas Corp. be named operator;
- b.) Provisions for applicant and all working interest owners to participate in the costs of drilling, completing, equipping, and operating the well;
- c.) In the event a mineral owner or working interest owner fails to elect to participate, then provision be made to recoup out of production, the costs of the drilling, completing, equipping, and operating the well, including a risk factor penalty of 156%;
