**APPLICATION OF CONOCO, INC. FOR  
PROMULGATION OF SPECIAL POOL

NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") that Order No. R-10854, issued in Case No. 11773 and dated August 4, 1997, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Decretory Paragraph No. (3) on pages 5 and 6 of said Order No. R-10854 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

" (3) Pursuant to Paragraph A of Section 70-2-18, NMSA (1978), contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, existing wells in the West Maljamar-Devonian Pool shall have dedicated thereto 160 acres in accordance with the foregoing pool rules; or, pursuant to Paragraph C of said Section 70-2-18, existing wells may have non-standard spacing or proration units established by the Division and dedicated thereto.

Failure to file new Forms C-102 with the Division dedicating 160 acres to a well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within sixty days from the date of this order shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable. Until said Form C-102 has been filed or until a non-standard unit has been approved, and subject to said sixty-day limitation, each well presently drilling to or completed in the West Maljamar-Devonian Pool or in the Devonian formation within one mile thereof shall receive no more than one-half of a standard allowable for the pool."


(2) The corrections set forth in this order shall be entered nunc pro tunc as of August 4, 1997.
