On behalf of Stevens & Tull, Inc., I would appreciate you continuing the referenced case from the Commission docket schedule for April 9, 1998 to the docket now scheduled for June 18, 1998.

Stevens & Tull, Inc. is the applicant in this case and the only party involved. Division Order R-10921 approved Stevens & Tull, Inc.'s requested salt water disposal well but precluded them from using certain of the existing perforations for injection.
