

Advantages of Commingled Completion vs. Dual

- ▶ Ability to move 2 times the gas volume, increasing plunger efficiency, decreasing loading chances, maximizing gas production and extending the economic life of a well.
- ▶ The ability to use larger tubing, enabling the operator to lift more liquid and gas with less psi. This increases plunger efficiency, maximizes gas production and extends the economic life of a well.
- ▶ Operations are easier and less expensive. Less hardware in the hole. More difficult to operate a plunger system with a packer in the hole (less gas pressure to move plunger).
