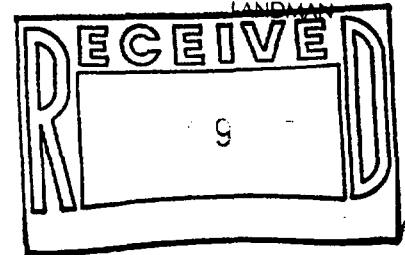

Pursuant to our conversation, Chesapeake hereby requests an extension of that certain Term Assignment effective June 1, 1997 covering Conoco's interest in the captioned acreage. Of the two other interest owners in the subject tract, one has granted Chesapeake a term assignment and the other has yet to commit their interest in writing. We have initiated force pooling procedures as a precaution, but if required to follow through with the procedures to procure the interest, we will not have sufficient time before our Term Assignment with Conoco expires on August 29, 1997.

Chesapeake has made a diligent effort to arrange for drilling in a timely manner under the terms of our agreement and may still commence drilling before the expiration date, but would very much appreciate an extension of the term of the subject Term Assignment until October 1, 1997 to insure that our current efforts will be worthwhile.


