APPLICATION

Comes now BURLINGTON RESOURCES OIL & GAS COMPANY (formerly Meridian Oil Inc.), by its attorneys, Kellahin & Kellahin, and in accordance with Section 70-2-17(c) (1978) applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order pooling certain owners of mineral interests from the base of the Bone Springs formation to the base of the Wolfcamp underlying the N/2 of Section 23, T26S, R30E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre gas spacing within said vertical extent, including but not limited to the Ross Draw-Wolfcamp Pool. Applicant seeks to be designated as the operator of the well. Said unit is to be dedicated to Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company's El Paso "23" Federal No. 2 which in accordance with Rule 111 is to be a multilateral directional wellbore whose Producing Intervals will be located within its Producing Area and dedicated to a Project Area consisting of the N/2 Section 23, T26S, R30E, NMPM. Also to be considered will be the costs of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the costs thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing said well.

In support of its application, Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company ("Burlington") states:

1. Burlington, is the proposed operator for a multi-lateral directional wellbore in the N/2 of Section 23, T26S, R30E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

- 2. Burlington has attempted to consolidate on a voluntary basis all of the oil and gas working interests ("operating rights") within a 320-acre gas spacing unit consisting of the N/2 of said Section 32 as a possible 320-acre spacing unit on which Burlington, as operator, intends to locate and drill the El Paso "31' Federal Well No. 2 as described above and as illustrated on Exhibits A and B, attached.
- 3. Despite its good faith efforts, Burlington has not been able to obtain the voluntary agreement of certain mineral owners as indicated on Exhibit "C".
- 4. In accordance with Division Rule 111, Burlington will submit to the Division its request for approval to drill the subject multilateral horizontal wellbore subject to the following:
 - (i) Project Area: 320-acre gas dedication (N/2 Section 23).
 - (ii) Producing Area: being not closer than 660 feet to any side boundary or closer than 1650 feet to any end boundary of the 320-acre spacing unit.
 - (iii) Bottom hole targets: not closer than 660 feet to any side boundary or closer than 1650 feet to any end boundary of the 320-acre spacing unit.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 70-2-17(c) NMSA (1978) and in order to obtain its just and equitable share of production from the subject well and this spacing unit, Burlington needs an order of the Division pooling the identified and described mineral interests involved in order to protect correlative rights and prevent waste.
- 6. In accordance with the Division's notice requirements, a copy of this application has been sent to the parties to be pooled as shown on Exhibit "C".
- 7. Burlington requests that this matter be set for a hearing before the Division on the next available Examiner's docket now scheduled for August 21, 1997.

WHEREFORE, Burlington, as applicant, requests that this application be set for hearing on August 21, 1997 before the Division's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the mineral interests described in this spacing unit for the drilling, completing and operating the subject well upon terms and conditions which include:

- (1) Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company be named operator;
- (2) provisions for applicant and all working interest owners to participate in the costs of drilling, completing, equipping and operating the well;
- in the event a working interest owner fails to elect to participate, then provision be made to recover out of production the costs of the drilling, completing, equipping and operating the well including a risk factor penalty of 200%
- (4) provision for overhead rates per month drilling and per month operating and a provision providing for an adjustment method of the overhead rates as provided by COPAS.
- (5) for such other and further relief as may be proper.


