

CASE 11861:

Application of Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation, for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing in the NE/4 of Section 19, including the North Shoe Bar-Wolfcamp Pool and tall formations developed on 40-acre spacing in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 36 East. Said unit is to be dedicated to its Gandy 19 Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard location 810 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 19 to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 3 miles southwest of Lovington, New Mexico.
