CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: This is a specially called hearing of the Oil Conservation Commission to consider one application. It's the Application of KCS Medallion Resources, Inc., for an unorthodox gas well location in Eddy County, New Mexico. This is Case Number 11,925. This Application is being heard by the Commission, de novo.

I'm Lori Wrotenbery, Chairman of the Oil
Conservation Commission. To my right is Commissioner Jami
Bailey. Commissioner Bill LeMay is not present today, but
we do have a quorum so we will continue to consider this
