CARROLL: Application of Fasken Land and 5 6 Minerals, Ltd., for compulsory pooling and an unorthodox gas well location, Eddy County, New Mexico. 7 EXAMINER STOGNER: Would somebody bring me up to 8 date on this matter? 9 Yes, Mr. Examiner. MR. KELLAHIN: 10 I'm Tom Kellahin of the Santa Fe law firm of 11 12 Kellahin and Kellahin. 13 The Fasken case, as well as the Redstone pooling case that's shown later in the docket, were heard by 14 Examiner Catanach at the last hearing on -- What was that? 15 February 5th? 16 17 EXAMINER STOGNER: -- for evidentiary purposes. Mr. Catanach allowed Redstone and Fasken to proceed with 18 19 the presentation of both of those cases. The Redstone case is on the docket today for 20 advertisement purposes only. 21 The Fasken case is on the docket today but needs 22 to be continued to the March 5th docket, because subsequent 23 to the hearing Fasken amended its application to include an 24 alternative orientation for the spacing unit. And so it's 25

been readvertised for the 5th.

But in terms of evidence, we had the presentation of the witnesses on February 5th.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Bruce?

MR. BRUCE: I agree with Mr. Kellahin, and if you could call the Redstone case at this time, I have a couple of affidavits to introduce, and we can get that case out of the way also.

EXAMINER STOGNER: If there's no objection, then at this time I'll call Case Number 11,927.

MR. KELLAHIN: No objection, same appearances, Mr. Examiner.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay.

MR. CARROLL: Application of Redstone Oil and Gas
Company for compulsory pooling and unorthodox gas well
location, Eddy County, New Mexico.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Bruce?

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, as Mr. Kellahin stated, the testimony was presented in this case, and I have for submission today an affidavit regarding notice and an affidavit from my landman, marked Exhibits 14 and 15, which -- The affidavit of the landman simply shows that he sent out a notice -- or a proposal letter to the interest owners involved.

I would note also that Mr. Kellahin, on behalf of

Fasken Land and Minerals, has filed a Motion to Dismiss, 1 which I have not had a chance to respond to, and I believe 2 once I respond to it we should probably argue that in front 3 of Mr. Catanach. 4 MR. KELLAHIN: Procedurally, Mr. Stogner, Mr. 5 Bruce is right, there is a Motion to Dismiss the Redstone 6 7 Application. I would recommend to you that we keep these all before Mr. Catanach. 8 9 I also have some affidavits to submit, which we will do so prior to the February 5th hearing. Mr. Bruce 10 and I will coordinate with Mr. Carroll and Mr. Catanach how 11 12 to complete these two cases. 13 MR. BRUCE: I move the admission of the Exhibits 14 and 15, Mr. Examiner. 14 15 I have no objection. MR. KELLAHIN: EXAMINER STOGNER: Exhibits 14 and 15 will be 16 17 admitted into evidence and made part of the record of Case 18 11,927. Is there anything further by either party at this 19 20 particular time? 21 MR. BRUCE: No, sir. EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, I'm going to defer the 22 23 Motion to Dismiss the Redstone case filed by Fasken to March 5th, at which time Case Number 11,927 will be 24
