NEARBURG EXPLORATION COMPANY, L.L.C. ("Nearburg"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an unorthodox gas well location, and in support of this application states:

- 1. Applicant is the operator of the S/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and proposes to drill its Jade "34" Federal Com. Well No. 1 to the Morrow formation, Undesignated Gem-Morrow East Gas Pool, at an unorthodox gas well location 1650 feet from the South line and 1150 feet from the East line of said Section 34.
- 2. This Bureau of Land Management will not permit this well to be drilled at a standard location due to its proximity to potash reserves but has approved the requested unorthodox location. Nearburg therefore seeks an exception to Oil Conservation Division General Rule 104 C (2) (b) to permit the drilling of this well at this unorthodox gas well location.
- 3. A standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the S/2 of said Section 34 will be dedicated to the well.

4. Approval of this application will afford Nearburg the opportunity to produce

its just and equitable share of the reserves under the subject spacing and proration unit and

will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the

protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. requests that this application

be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 30, 1998,

that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division. and that the Division

enter its Order granting this application.
